

Monsoon Session of Parliament Begins: The Monsoon Session of Parliament commenced on July 21, 2025, after a break of over three and a half months. The government has lined up 15 bills for consideration, including eight new ones and seven pending. Key bills include the Income-Tax Bill, 2025, and amendments to various laws related to finance, education, mining, and shipping. A new digital attendance system for MPs has also been rolled out. 


