

Vice Presidential Election: The election for the Vice President of India is taking place today at the Parliament House Complex. The counting of votes is scheduled for 6 PM. The NDA has nominated C.P. Radhakrishnan, while the INDIA bloc has named retired judge B. Sudershan Reddy as their candidate.

NIA Searches: The National Investigation Agency (NIA) conducted searches at 22 locations across five states and Jammu and Kashmir in connection with a terror conspiracy case.


