Political and Diplomatic Developments

Rahul Gandhi's Allegations: Leader of the Opposition Rahul Gandhi accused Chief Election Commissioner Gyanesh Kumar of "protecting those who are destroying Indian democracy." alleging "vote theft." The Election Commission of India (ECI) and the BJP have both termed the allegations baseless.

India-Nepal Relations: Prime Minister Narendra Modi held a telephone conversation with Sushila Karki, the Prime Minister of Nepal's Interim Government, expressing support for her country's efforts to restore peace.

GDP and Inflation Outlook: Chief Economic Adviser Dr. V. Ananth Nageswaran stated that India's GDP growth is expected to remain stable, while a report from S&P Global highlighted India's "Goldilocks moment" of strong growth and subdued inflation.

Corporate **Investment:** Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman urged Indian industries to increase their investments, asserting that the government has delivered on necessary reforms. A new report also shows that India's number of millionaire households has surged by 90% since 2021.

GST on Medicines: In a move to reduce out-ofpocket expenses for patients, the Delhi Drugs Control Department directed pharmaceutical companies to revise MRPs on medicines and medical devices following the recent GST rate cuts, which made many life-saving drugs completely tax-free.


