The Dilmun civilization, also known as Telmun, flourished in the eastern Arabian Peninsula, with its main centers being Bahrain Island and Kuwait's Failaka Island. It also extended to Saudi Arabia, Qatar, Oman, and the Iranian coast along the Persian Gulf.
