## Today in History on 06 AUG

➤ 1825: Bolivia gains independence from Peru.

In 1825, Bolivia gains independence from Peru. On August 6, 1825, Bolivia declared its independence at a congress in Chuquisaca. With this declaration, Bolivia became an independent republic. Bolivia's independence war, against Spanish colonial rule, began in 1809 and ended with the declaration of independence in 1825. The war involved several battles, including the Battle of Ayacucho, after which Bolivia gained independence.

### 1862: Madras High Court established.

The Madras High Court was established in 1862. It was one of the three High Courts established under the Indian High Courts Act 1861, the other two being Calcutta and Bombay. However, in 1865 new Letters

Patent were issued for these courts, also known as Amended Letters Patent. The Madras High Court complex is famous for its vast area as it is the second largest judicial structure in the world after the courts in London.



### 1914: Austria declares war on Russia.

In 1914, Austria declared war on Russia. This event was a key part of the start of World War I. Russia entered World War I in July 1914. It was allied with Britain and France and fought against Germany and Austria-Hungary. Russia's economy was not ready for a major war and thus Russia lost to Germany.

In 1962, Jamaica gained independence from the United Kingdom. This happened on August 6, 1962. This day is celebrated as Independence Day in Jamaica. Jamaica became independent on August 6, 1962 and remained a member of the British Commonwealth. The United States recognized Jamaica's independence on August 16, 1962 with the establishment of the US Embassy in Kingston. Jamaica's independence meant that Britain no longer had control over the country's affairs. Jamaica created its own constitution, symbols, army, currency, and passports. Alexander Bustamante became the first elected Prime Minister.



1996: NASA raised the possibility of life on Mars.

In 1996, NASA made an important claim about the possibility of life on Mars. They reported the discovery of possible evidence of microscopic fossils in a Martian meteorite (ALH84001). However, this discovery was not widely accepted in the scientific

community, and debate continues today over whether there was actually evidence of life on Mars.

Russia is India's major crude oil supplier. India is the world's third-largest oil importer and consumer. Russia's share in India's total crude oil supply is about 35-40%. Before the war with Ukraine, this share was less than 0.2 percent. According to data obtained by Reuters, India imported about 1.75 million barrels of Russian oil per day from January to June this year. This is 1% more than a year ago.


