Today in History on 27 AUG

➤ 1604: The Golden Temple in Amritsar houses the Guru Granth Sahib, the holy book of Sikhism.

In 1604, the fifth Sikh Guru, Sri Guru Arjan Dev installed the Guru Granth Sahib, the holy and final book of Sikhism, in the Golden Temple in Amritsar. The dome of the Golden Temple was covered in gold by Maharaja Ranjit Singh. He covered the upper part of the temple with 750 kg of pure gold in the 19th century. It is an important pilgrimage site for Sikhism and is also known as the "Golden City" Additionally, Amritsar is also famous for its delicious food and shopping opportunities.

▶ 1870: India's first labour organisation, Shramjeevi Sangh, was founded.

In 1870, Sasipada Banerjee founded the Working Men's Club in Bengal, which was an early step

towards organising labour in India, but it is not seen as a full-fledged labour organisation but rather a welfare and moral education body. India's first organised labour union, the Bombay Mill Hands' Association, was founded by M N Lokhande in 1890.



1947: Close to India's independence, the country's own news agency, Press


Temporary Suspension of Postal Services to the United States of America

India's Department of Posts has announced the temporary suspension of international postal services to the United States starting August, 2025, in response to a recent policy shift by the U S government. Following Executive Order 14324, the U S will withdraw the duty-free de minimis exemption for imports up to USD 800, leading to customs duties on all incoming goods, regardless of value.

NorthEast United Retain Durand Cup 2025 with 6-1 Win

NorthEast United FC stamped their authority on Indian football by retaining the Durand Cup title with a dominant 6-1 victory over debutants Diamond Harbour FC in the 134th edition of the tournament. The final, played at the Vivekananda Yuba Bharati Krirangan in Kolkata, saw the Highlanders lift the trophy for the second year in a row, becoming the first team in 25 years to successfully defend the title.



RBI Clears SMBC's 24.99% Stake in Yes Bank

In a landmark decision for India's financial sector the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has granted approval to Japan's Sumitomo Mitsui Banking Corporation (SMBC) to acquire up to 24.99% stake in Yes Bank. This move, initially structured as a 20% acquisition worth USD 1.6 billion, is now set to become one of the largest cross-border M&A transactions in India's banking industry.



CM's Breakfast Scheme expansion

Tamil Nadu Chief Minister will launch the expansion of the Chief Minister's Breakfast Scheme to Stateaided urban primary schools on August, 2025. Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann will attend the launch as the chief guest. The expansion will benefit approximately 3.05 lakh additional students across the State. As of February 2025, about 17.53 lakh students in 34,987 schools have benefited from the programme.

Three tiger-inhabited areas in South 24 Parganas - Matla, Raidighi and Ramganga - have been added. The expansion, already approved by the **National Tiger** Conservation Authority (NTCA), brings all tiger-rich mangroves under integrated management.




