Today in History on 03 JAN

> 1831 - Savitribai Phule was born

Savitribai Phule was born on 3 January 1831. Her father's name was Khandoji Naivese and mother's name was Lakshmibai. Savitribai Phule was married to Jyotirao Phule in 1841. Savitribai Phule was the first principal of India's first girls' school and the founder of the first farmers' school. Mahatma Jyotirao is considered one of the most important figures in the social reform movement in Maharashtra and India. He is known for his efforts to educate women and Dalit castes.

> 1876 - Turkey's first constitution proclaimed.

In 1876 a constitution for Turkey was drafted by the Armenian Krikor Odian, secretary to the reformer Midhat Pasha, and proclaimed and almost immediately revoked by Sultan Abdul Hamid. The Turkish Constitution of 1921 was the fundamental law for Turkey from 1921 to 1924. It is generally accepted that the constitution was the result of the most democratic constitution-making process in Turkish history.



▶ 1894-Rabindranath **Tagore** inaugurated the 'Paush Mela' in Shantiniketan.

Shantiniketan is famous for Rabindranath Tagore, Visva-Bharati University and Paush Mela. Paush Mela was started in 1894 by Maharshi Devendranath Tagore to commemorate the anniversary of the Temple established in 1891 Brahma Shantiniketan. Paush Mela of Shantiniketan is one of the popular cultural fairs of Bengal. This fair

➤ 1909 - Albert becomes King of the Belgians.

Albert was born in Brussels as the fifth child and second son of Prince Philippe, Count of Flanders, and Princess Marie of Hohenzollern-Sigmaringen. Albert succeeded his uncle Leopold II on the Belgian throne in 1909. He married Elisabeth of Bavaria, with whom he had three children. Albert ruled during an eventful period in Belgian history, including the duration of World War I (1914-1918), when much of Belgium was occupied by German forces.



➤ 1968- Launch of the country's first meteorological rocket 'Maneka'.

The country's first meteorological rocket 'Maneka' was launched in the year 1968. The RH-100 was a single-stage solid-fuel rocket capable of carrying its payload to an altitude of 55 km or more. When it was combined with a 650 mm long and 40 mm wide copper shaft dart used for meteorological research, it was called the Maneka-I rocket.



Vitul Kumar Appointed Officiating DG of CRPF



During a visit to the Army War College (AWC) in Mhow Cantonment, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh set an ambitious target of Rs 50,000 crore in defence exports by 2029.







➤ GDP to Grow at 6.6% in FY25: RBI

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI), in its December 2024 Financial Stability Report (FSR), projected India's GDP growth at 6.6% for FY25, driven by a revival in rural consumption, increased government spending, and strong services exports. Despite a moderation in GDP growth to 6% in H1 FY25 from 8.2% in H1 FY24, the RBI highlighted India's economic resilience, supported by macroeconomic fundamentals, improved asset quality in banks, and robust financial system indicators.



Rajat Verma Appointed CEO of DBS Bank India

Rajat Verma, the current head of the Institutional Banking Group at DBS Bank India, has been appointed as the new CEO of DBS Bank India, effective March 1, 2025. This announcement comes after the retirement of Surojit Shome, who has been at the helm since 2015. Verma's appointment, subject to Reserve Bank of India (RBI) approval, marks a new phase for DBS India as it continues its growth trajectory in India, one of the bank's key markets.



The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has announced a name lookup facility for Real-Time Gross Settlement (RTGS) and National Electronic Funds Transfer (NEFT) systems, aiming to reduce fraud and errors. This feature, similar to what Unified Payments Interface (UPI) and Immediate Payment Service (IMPS) offer, will allow remitters to verify the beneficiary's name before initiating transactions.

With only trained women officials deployed at all 31 polling stations, the Mahe Assembly constituency created history. The sex ratio in the Union Territory has also increased significantly, rising from 1127 in 2023 to 1130 in 2024. The ECI data also shows a 5.19% increase in registered voters. Nearly 70% of the 151 registered transgender voters cast their vote. According to the data, the number of NOTA votes declined from 12,199 in 2019 to 9763 in 2024.






