

Today in History on 03 July

> 1979 - Construction of Vidyasagar Bridge begins

In 1979, the construction of Vidyasagar Setu in Kolkata began. This bridge is built over the Hooghly River and is also known as the "Second Howrah Bridge". Its construction began on July 3, 1979 and it was commissioned on October 10, 1992. This bridge is India's first cable-stayed bridge.



1938 - First successful helicopter flight

In 1938, Igor Sikorsky designed and began building the Vought-Sikorsky VS-300 helicopter, which was first flown on September 14, 1939, according to Sikorsky Archives. This helicopter was a singleengine, three-bladed rotor and had a single verticalplane tail rotor for anti-torque. The VS-300 is considered "the world's first successful single lifting rotor helicopter." This helicopter, which could reach

speeds of 90 kilometers per hour, demonstrated new degree of stability and control in flight.



1986 – Reinauguration of the Statue of Liberty

In 1986, the Statue of Liberty was reinaugurated. The reinauguration took place as part of the Statue's centennial celebration. President Ronald Reagan presided over the ceremony to re-light the restored statue. The celebration ran from July 3 to July 6 and included several events, including a parade and fireworks in New York City. In 1984, an extensive restoration of the Statue of Liberty began, which was completed by the 1986 centennial.



The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has reported that gross non-performing assets (GNPAs) in the banking sector declined to a multi-decade low of 2.3% in March 2025, down from 2.6% in September 2024. However, the central bank warned that GNPAs could rise to 2.6% by March 2027, according to its biannual Financial Stability Report (FSR).





The name "Nyishiorum" is named in honour of the Nyishi tribal community for their forest conservation efforts.



The H-2A rocket took off from the Tanegashima Space Center southwestern Japan, carrying the GOSAT-GW satellite as part of Tokyo's effort to mitigate climate change. The satellite was released into the planned orbit about 16 minutes later.




