



Today in History on 21 MAR

➤ 1413: Henry V is crowned King of England.

In 1413, following the death of Henry IV on March 20, Henry V became King of England, and was crowned at Westminster Abbey on April 9. Henry V, known for his military prowess, focused on unifying the kingdom and establishing his authority. He introduced the formal use of English in government proceedings and sought to bridge differences that had cast doubt on his father's claim to the throne.



1791: British forces capture Bangalore from Tipu Sultan.

In 1791, British forces capture Bangalore from Tipu Sultan, which was then part of the Mysore Kingdom. Tipu Sultan was the ruler of the Mysore Kingdom, a powerful kingdom in South India in the late 18th century. There were several wars between the British East India Company and the Mysore Kingdom, known as the Anglo-Mysore Wars.



➤ 1836: First public library started in Kolkata, now called the National Library.

In 1836, the Calcutta Public Library was established in Kolkata, which later became the National Library of India. The library was established for reference and lending purposes, on the principle of selffinancing, open to all irrespective of class, colour or nationality. In 1903, Lord Curzon merged the Calcutta Public Library with the Imperial Library. After India's independence, the Imperial Library was renamed the National Library in 1948.

1954: **Filmfare** First **Awards** ceremony held.

In 1954, the first Filmfare Awards ceremony was held on 21 March at the Metro Theatre in Mumbai (then Bombay), honouring the best artists of Hindi cinema in 1953. The first awards ceremony had only five categories—Best Film, Best Director, Best Actor, Best Actress and Best Music Director. The winners were the only nominees in their categories. Starting from 1959, a number of nominees were gradually added. By 2024, there were around 30 awards in four broad categories—Popular, Critics, Special and Technical.



1912 - Khwaja Khurshid Anwar - was a famous musician.

Khwaja Khurshid Anwar (21 March 1912 - 30 October 1984) was a Pakistani filmmaker, writer, director and composer who gained recognition in both India and Pakistan. He is considered one of the most original and inventive music directors of his generation.





2025 Australian Grand Prix: Lando Norris secured a thrilling victory for McLaren in a dramatic season opener on March, 2025, in Melbourne, Australia. The race featured changing weather conditions, multiple crashes, and a late-race downpour. Despite briefly losing the lead to Max Verstappen (Red Bull), Norris reclaimed it to win. George Russell (Mercedes), Andrea Kimi Antonelli (Mercedes), and Alexander Albon (Williams) rounded out the Top 5, making it an exciting start to the Formula 1 season.



Kabaddi World Cup 2025 Begins in England

The Kabaddi World Cup 2025 kicks off in England, marking the first time it is hosted outside Asia. The Indian men's team starts its campaign against Italy in Wolverhampton. The seven-day tournament features 10 men's teams (India in Group B with Italy, Scotland, Wales, and China) and 6 women's teams (India in Group D with Wales and Poland).



➤ India's First PPP Green Waste Processing Plant in Indore


Indore is set to establish India's first green waste processing plant under the PPP model at Bicholi Hapsi under the Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban. Spanning 55,000 sq. ft., the plant, developed with Astronomical Industries Pvt. Ltd., will convert wood, branches, leaves, and flowers into valuable resources. It will generate revenue for IMC and produce wooden pellets as a coal alternative, promoting sustainability, innovation, and a circular economy while reducing pollution.




