> 1668 - England takes over the Indian city of Mumbai.

In 1668, King Charles II of England leases the city of Bombay (now Mumbai) to the English East India Company for an annual rent of £10, marking an important step in the company's establishment in India. The East India Company saw Bombay as a strategic location for trade and established its Western India headquarters here in 1687, moving from Surat.

1958 - America's third successful satellite "Explorer III" was launched by the US Army.

> In 1958, on March 26, the US Army successfully launched the "Explorer III" satellite, America's third successful satellite. It was the second successful launch in the Explorer program, and in its design and mission it was almost identical to the first American satellite Explorer 1. Which was launched in November 1954 using a slightly modified Redstone missile combined with a solid propellant rocket cluster upper stage to put a satellite into orbit.

In 1971, under the leadership of Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, Bangladesh declared its independence from Pakistan, which took place on 26 March. On 10 April, the Provisional Government of Bangladesh issued a proclamation based on the previous declaration and established an interim constitution for the independence movement.



> 2006 - The 18th Commonwealth Games concluded in Melbourne.

The 2006 Commonwealth Games, officially the XVIII Commonwealth Games and commonly known as Melbourne 2006, were an international multi-sport event for members of the Commonwealth of Nations held in Melbourne. Australia between 15 and 26 March 2006. It was the fourth time Australia had hosted the Commonwealth Games. It was also the largest sporting event held in Melbourne, surpassing the 1956 Summer Olympics in terms of the number of teams competing, athletes competing and events held.

India Imposes Anti-Dumping Duty on **Five Chinese Products**

India has imposed anti-dumping duties on five Chinese products—Soft Ferrite Cores, vacuum aluminium insulated flasks. foil, Trichloro Isocyanuric Acid, and PVC Paste Resin—to protect domestic industries from unfairly priced imports. Recommended by the DGTR, the duties will be in place for up to five years, ensuring fair trade practices. The duty rates vary, with Soft Ferrite Cores facing up to 35% duty, while other products have specific per-tonne tariffs.



Public Sector Banks Witness a 33% Surge in Dividend Payouts in FY24, Reflecting Strong Financial Growth

Public Sector Banks (PSBs) in India achieved record net profits and a 33% rise in dividend payouts, reaching ₹27,830 crore in FY24 (up from ₹20,964 crore in FY23). The Indian government received ₹18,013 crore, reinforcing PSBs' role in national revenue generation. This financial strength and highlight profitability surge the improved performance and stability of PSBs.



RRBs Get Five More Years to Amortize Additional Pension Liabilities

The RBI has granted Regional Rural Banks (RRBs) an additional five years (from FY25) to amortize pension liabilities under the Employee Pension Scheme 2018, retroactive to November 1, 1993. RRBs must allocate 20% annually, ensure full recognition in financial statements, and disclose unamortized expenditure while Tier-I Capital remains unaffected.


