Today, only two living species remain – the coelacanth of the western Indian Ocean and the Indonesian coelacanth.

This is the first time a cryogenic engine operating on a gas-generator cycle has been started in boot-strap mode without the assistance of any other system. This will enable more easy and reliable engine restarts after a single shutdown on future LVM3 flights, increasing mission flexibility.
