➤ **1813: Mexico gained independence from Spain.**

Mexico gained independence from Spain on November, 1813.

The Mexican War of Independence was an armed conflict and political process that resulted in Mexico's independence from the Spanish Empire.

It was not a single, coherent event, but rather local and regional conflicts that occurred over a period of time and can be considered a revolutionary civil war.



➤ **1860: Abraham Lincoln was elected the 16th president of the United States.**

Abraham Lincoln was the 16th president of the United States, serving from 1861 until his assassination in 1865. He led the United States during the American Civil War, preserved the nation as a constitutional union, defeated the Confederacy, played a major role in the abolition of slavery, expanded the power of the federal government, and modernized the American economy.

Lincoln was born into poverty in a log cabin in Kentucky and raised on the frontier, primarily in Indiana. He educated himself and became a lawyer, Whig Party leader, Illinois state legislator, and U.S. Representative from Illinois.



➤ **1913: Mahatma Gandhi led 'The Great March' against apartheid policies in South Africa.**

On November, 1913, Mahatma Gandhi led 'The Great March' against apartheid policies in South Africa. Mandela's fight against apartheid rule in South Africa is equal to Gandhi's fight against British rule in India.

➤ **1962: The National Security Council was established.**

The National Security Council of India is an executive government agency tasked with advising the Prime Minister's Office on matters of national security and strategic interest.

It was established by former Prime Minister of India Atal Bihari Vajpayee with Brajesh Mishra as the first National Security Advisor.



➤ **1937: Lok Sabha member Yashwant Sinha was born.**

Yashwant Sinha is an Indian administrator and politician. He served as Finance Minister under Prime Minister Chandrashekhar from 1990 to 1991 and again under Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee from March 1998 to July 2002.

The opposition has fielded him as its presidential candidate for the 2022 presidential election.

In a bold move to future-proof India's digital identity system, the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has launched 'Aadhaar Vision 2032'. This transformative roadmap aims to make Aadhaar more secure, intelligent, and globally aligned by integrating Artificial Intelligence (AI), Blockchain, Quantum Computing, and next-generation encryption technologies.



**Key Points:-**

- The framework has been guided by a high-level expert committee of technology leaders to make Aadhaar compliant with the Digital Personal Data Protection Act and global cyber security standards.
- The Ministry further said that this roadmap is about sustaining technological leadership and reinforcing Aadhaar's role as a secure, inclusive and people-centric digital identity.

#### ➤ Russia Launches Khabarovsk Submarine, Carrier for Poseidon Drone

Russia on November 2025 launched the nuclear-powered submarine Khabarovsk from the Sevmash shipyard in Severodvinsk. Officials described the class as a carrier for advanced underwater weapons and robotic systems, and Russian media and defence sources say these submarines are intended to carry the nuclear-powered unmanned underwater vehicle known as Poseidon.



#### Key Points:-

- Platform and Yard: Khabarovsk was launched at Sevmash (a Russian shipyard known for major submarine programs) and designed by the Rubin Central Design Bureau.
- Payload Used: According to Russian statements and media reporting, this submarine was intended to carry the Poseidon unmanned underwater vehicle and other robotic underwater systems.

#### ➤ Vice Admiral B Sivakumar Takes Charge as Chief of Materiel

Vice Admiral B Sivakumar, AVSM, VSM, took charge as the 40th Chief of Materiel (COM) of the Indian Navy, succeeding Vice Admiral Kiran Deshmukh, AVSM (Ati Vishisht Seva Medal), VSM (Vishisht Seva Medal). This appointment brings to the fore an officer known for his technical excellence, leadership acumen, and vast experience in naval engineering and ship acquisition.



#### Key Points:-

- Vice Admiral B Shivakumar is an alumnus of the 70th NDA course and was commissioned into the Indian Navy as an Electrical Officer on 1 July 1987.
- In a service career spanning 38 years, he has contributed in various fields – warship systems, electrical engineering, naval dockyards and strategic acquisition programmes.

➤ **Kane Williamson Retires from T20Is, Ends Career with 93 Matches**

On November 2025, Kane Williamson, New Zealand's celebrated batter and former captain, announced his retirement from T20 Internationals (T20Is) with immediate effect. His decision came just days ahead of a five-match home series against the West Indies, and marks the end of a 14-year T20I journey that began in 2011. Known for his composure and leadership, Williamson exits the format after 93 matches, becoming New Zealand's second-highest run-scorer in T20Is with 2575 runs at an average of 33, including 18 fifties and a personal best of 95.

➤ **SBI Joins India Bullion Exchange as Special Category Client**

In a significant step toward modernising India's gold import ecosystem, the State Bank of India (SBI) announced its first gold trade as a Special Category Client (SCC) on the India International Bullion Exchange (IIBX). The move, announced on November 2025, is expected to reshape how gold is imported and traded in India, especially benefiting MSME jewellers through better pricing and streamlined access.

➤ **Renewable Energy Capacity and Projects**

Since 2021, Tamil Nadu's wind energy sector has attracted over ₹5,700 crore and added 816 megawatts of capacity. An additional ₹4,200 crore is planned for 600 megawatts of new wind projects. The State's solar energy sector has received over ₹23,500 crore for 6,736 megawatts of projects. Solar projects worth ₹39,000 crore (5,700 megawatts) are under advanced approval stages.
