

To ensure wider access to essential legal documentation services, the Ministry of Law and Justice has notified the Notaries (Amendment) Rules, 2025, significantly increasing the maximum number of notaries in Gujarat, Tamil Nadu, Rajasthan, and Nagaland. The move aims to meet the surging demand for notary services due to expanding administrative units and growing population pressures.

Key Points:-

The amendment has been made under Section 15 of the Notaries Act, 1952, which empowers the Central Government to amend the rules governing notary appointments and practices.


