▶ 1598: Dutch sailors discover Mauritius.

Arabs arrived before the 10th century, Malays in the 15th century and the Portuguese in the early 1500s. It was captured by the Dutch in 1598, who named it after Maurice of Nassau, who was then stadtholder, or chief magistrate, of the Netherlands. The Dutch left in 1710 and the French took over in 1715 and renamed it Isle de France. Mauritius gained independence on March 12, 1968. The Mauritius Labour Party (MLP), headed by Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam, ruled Mauritius during the first 14 years of independence.


➤ 2004: European Parliament passes resolution imposing sanctions on **Maldives**

Andhra Pradesh's natural marvels, the Tirumala Hills and the Erra Matti Dibbalu (Red Sand Dunes) near Visakhapatnam, have achieved a major milestone by being added to the UNESCO Tentative List of World Heritage Sites. This crucial first step indicates India's and the state government's intent to ensure long-term preservation of these unique geological and ecological formations.



➤ India Backs UNGA Resolution on Palestine Two-State Solution

In a significant diplomatic development, India voted in favour of a United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) resolution endorsing the "New York Declaration" on the peaceful settlement of the Palestine issue through the two-state solution. The resolution was passed on September, 2025, with 142 countries supporting, 10 opposing, and 12 abstaining. This vote reaffirms India's long-standing position on the Israeli-Palestinian supporting the creation of a sovereign, independent, and viable State of Palestine, coexisting peacefully with a secure State of Israel within recognized borders.



India, Norway Hold First Maritime Security Dialogue

India and Norway convened their inaugural Maritime Security, Disarmament, and Non-Proliferation Dialogue in Oslo on September 2025, marking a significant development in their growing strategic partnership. This dialogue signals a shared commitment to promoting maritime stability, upholding international norms, and enhancing multilateral cooperation on key global security challenges.



India has scripted a remarkable chapter in its tennis history by defeating ninth-seeded Switzerland 3-1 in their Davis Cup 2025 World Group I tie held at the Swiss Tennis Arena in Biel. This win not only earns India a spot in the 2026 Davis Cup Qualifiers, but also ends a 32-year wait for an away win against a European nation.



As of July 2025, 12 insurance companies have issued nearly 1,600 ISBs as bid security and 207 ISBs as performance security, worth a total of ₹10,369 crore.

India's retail inflation rate (CPI-based) rose to 2.07% in August 2025, up 46 basis points from the revised 1.61% in July 2025. Although it has increased, the rate is still well below the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) target of 4%. This provides relief to ordinary households and creates scope for maintaining monetary policy laxity.

Advanced Systems in collaboration with Spanish defence company Indra. This is the first time Lanza-N is operational outside Spain. Tata Advanced Systems has become the first Indian company to manufacture and integrate next-generation naval surveillance radars. The radar has successfully passed sea trials with naval and air platforms at various radar cross-sections. A radar assembly and testing facility has been set up in Karnataka to expedite supplies. Lanza-N can detect drones, supersonic fighter aircraft, anti-radiation missiles and naval platforms.

Isobutanol is a flammable alcohol-based compound and is commonly used as a solvent in various industries, including paints and coatings. Mr Gadkari's announcement comes amid sharp criticism of the government over blending 20% ethanol in petrol.

Recently, a study published in Nature Reviews Disease Primers took a closer look at sarcoidosis. Sarcoidosis is an inflammatory disease in which immune cells form granulomas in organs, primarily the lungs. Granulomas are most common in the lungs and lymph nodes, but can also affect the eyes, skin, heart and other organs. Its exact cause is unknown, but it is associated with genetic changes and triggers such as bacteria, viruses, dust or chemicals. Symptoms can range from mild to severe, including cough, shortness of breath, shin splints, eye pain and redness. Some cases resolve on their own, while others become chronic and can lead to fibrosis with scarring in the lungs. There is no cure, but treatment with drugs reduces the immune response and prevents damage to organs.
