Historical and Technical Events of 3th April 2026

1975 - Bill Gates and Paul Allen create Microsoft.



It was founded on April, 1975, when most Americans used typewriters. Two childhood friends, Bill Gates and Paul Allen, created Microsoft, which makes computer software. In 1979, Microsoft moved from New Mexico to Washington State and grew into a major multinational technology corporation. In the 1980s, personal computer operating systems dominated the market with MS-DOS and later Windows.

1460: University of Basel founded in Switzerland.



The University of Basel is a university in Basel, Switzerland. Founded on April 1460, it is the oldest university in Switzerland and one of the oldest surviving universities in the world. The affiliated Basel University Library is one of the largest and most important libraries in Switzerland. The university hosts faculties of theology, law, medicine, humanities and social sciences, science, psychology, and business and economics, as well as numerous cross-disciplinary subjects and institutes

1722: Jacob Roggeveen Discovers Eastern Ireland.



In 1722, Jacob Roggeveen discovered Eastern Ireland. Jacob Roggeveen was a Dutch explorer who was sent to discover Terra Australis and Davis Land, but instead found Easter Island (so called because he landed there on Easter Sunday). Jacob Roggeveen also discovered Bora Bora and Maupiti of the Society Islands, as well as Samoa. He planned the expedition with his brother Jan Roggeveen, who remained in the Netherlands.

1916: The U.S. Senate approves entry into World War I.



In 1916, the United States passed the National Defense Act, which expanded the military and approved the construction of additional warships. The United States Army was still significantly smaller than the armies in Europe. As a result, the United States had to mobilize quickly for the war.

1889: Famous Hindi poet, writer, playwright and journalist Makhanlal Chaturvedi was born on April 1889 in Madhya Pradesh.



Famous Hindi poet, writer, playwright and journalist Makhanlal Chaturvedi was born on April 1889 at a place called Babai in Hoshangabad district of Madhya Pradesh. He received his early education at home, after which he got involved

in teaching and literary creation. In 1913, he started editing the magazine 'Prabha' and in this process he came in contact with Ganesh Shankar Vidyarthi, whose patriotism and service had a deep impact on him.
