India Ranks 3rd Globally in Renewable Energy Capacity



In the year 2025 India has been emerged as the third-largest renewable energy market in world. With this it is marking the new milestone in its clean energy journey. According to the numbers released by the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA) the country have added around 45 GW of renewable capacity in a single year. The mainly this capacity is driven by solar and wind power energy.

RBI grants approval to Emirates National Bank of Dubai to acquire up to 74% stake in RBL Bank



The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has given its approval to United Arab Emirates (UAE)-based Emirates NBD (ENBD) PJSC to acquire up to a 74 per cent stake in RBL Bank for \$3 billion — the largest foreign investment in a domestic bank ever. Under the approval, RBL Bank will be treated as a foreign bank subsidiary with ENBD as its parent. The bank will be governed by provisions applicable to wholly owned subsidiaries of foreign banks, as outlined in the RBI's Commercial Banks – Governance Directions, 2025.

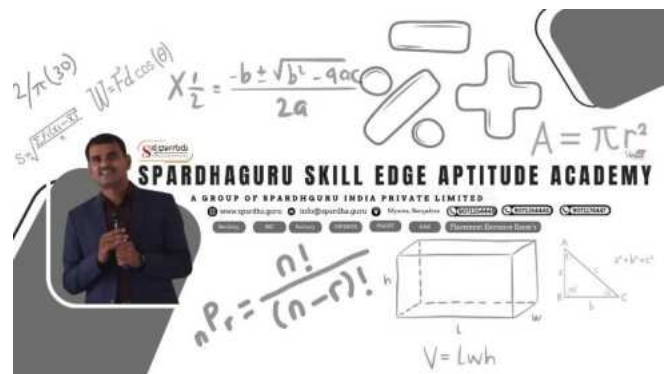

**Historical and Technical Events
of 6th April 2026**

1919: The Barbary Soviet Republic is established.



In 1919, the Bolsheviks declared the establishment of the Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic (SSR), leading to the creation of the Belarusian state between World War I and the Russian Civil War. Belarus was a republic of the Soviet Union (USSR). It existed as an independent state between 1920 and 1922, and then as one of the fifteen constituent republics of the USSR from 1922 to 1991, with its own constitution from 1990 to 1991. The republic was ruled by the Communist Party of Byelorussian. It was also known as the White Russian Soviet Socialist Republic.

1920: India's famous sitar player Pandit Ravi Shankar was born.



In 1920, on April, India's famous sitar player and musician, Pandit Ravi Shankar was born. Ravi Shankar received training in Indian classical music from Ustad Allaiddin Khan. Ravi Shankar, who spent time in India and abroad with his brother Uday Shankar's dance troupe, studied sitar from 1938 to 1944 and then started working independently. Later he also married Ustad Allaiddin Khan's daughter Annapurna.

1946: Syria's independence from France is ratified.



In 1946, Syria gained independence from France when the last French troops withdrew on April 1, leading to the establishment of the Syrian Republic. Syria declared its independence in 1941, but it took five years for French troops to be completely removed from the country. Since independence from France in April 1946, the country has been governed by the Baath Party. A state of emergency has been in place since 1963, which has led to members of the Assad family ruling the country since 1970.

1948: World Health Organization formed by the United Nations.



In 1948, on April, the World Health Organization (WHO) was established by the United Nations with the aim of achieving the highest possible level of health for all people. WHO's work is to improve health systems, prepare for disease and outbreaks, monitor and respond, and coordinate public health initiatives and campaigns. WHO is the United Nations agency dedicated to global health and security, connecting nations, partners and communities to promote health and serve vulnerable people.

1929: The first commercial flight arrived in India, when Britain's Imperial Airways' London-Cairo service was extended to Karachi.



This led to the establishment of a new mail and passenger service between England and colonial India in 1929. The

journey from London to Karachi and back took fifteen days. Passengers were usually businessmen or colonial administrators, and most flights carried about 20 passengers or fewer. Accidents were frequent: in the first six years, 32 people were killed in seven incidents. Imperial Airways never achieved the level of technological innovation of its competitors and was merged into the British Overseas Airways Corporation (BOAC) in 1939.
