FCI Signs Landmark MoU with WFP to Supply 2 Lakh MT Rice Annually



The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed between the **Food Corporation of India (FCI)** and the **World Food Programme (WFP)** marks a strategic shift in how India contributes to global stability.

1. The Core Objective

The primary goal is to combat global hunger and malnutrition. By partnering with the WFP (the food-assistance branch of the United Nations), India ensures that its surplus grain reaches conflict zones and areas hit by natural disasters.

2. Supply Logistics

- **Quantity:** 200,000 metric tonnes of rice will be supplied every year.
- **Quality:** The rice will contain up to **25% broken grains**, which is a standard grade suitable for large-scale humanitarian cooking and distribution.
- **Duration:** The contract is set for **five years**, providing a long-term, predictable supply chain for the WFP.

3. Financials & Pricing

The price has been fixed at ₹2,800 per quintal (100 kg) until March 31, 2026. This fixed pricing helps the WFP budget effectively for its global operations without worrying about immediate market volatility.

Consistency: Unlike the previous emergency-only shipments, this agreement guarantees a steady flow of nutrition regardless of global market spikes.

Strategic Pricing: Fixing the price at ₹2,800/quintal protects the WFP's budget from inflation, allowing them to feed more people with the same funds.

Global Standing: This positions India as a proactive leader in the Global South, moving beyond domestic self-sufficiency to global responsibility.

"strategic distance." This allows New Delhi to engage with major diplomatic shifts while avoiding a full endorsement of a body that some critics view as a rival to the United Nations.

2. Gaza Reconstruction

The meeting focused on rebuilding the Gaza Strip, with reconstruction costs estimated at \$70 billion.

- **Funding:** President Trump pledged \$10 billion from the U.S., while other member nations (including Saudi Arabia, UAE, and Qatar) committed an additional \$7 billion.
- **Infrastructure:** The goal is to rebuild housing, hospitals, and schools once Hamas is fully disarmed.

3. International Stabilization Force (ISF)

A core pillar of the plan is the mobilization of an International Stabilization Force.

- **Security:** This force is intended to maintain order, train a new Palestinian police force (approx. 12,000 officers), and oversee the transition to a technocratic government called the National Committee for the Administration of Gaza (NCAG).

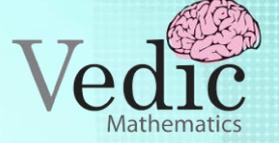

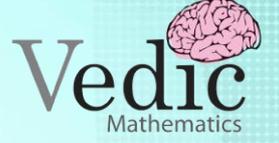

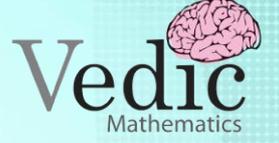

Union Home Minister to Launch Vibrant Villages Programme-II in Assam's Cachar District



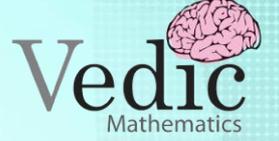

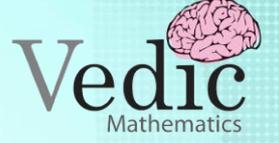

Tamil Nadu Second Economic Survey



The **Tamil Nadu Economic Survey** is a vital document that provides a comprehensive look at the state's financial health, sectoral growth, and future projections.
