Stuti Pradhan from the state of Sikkim has been selected to represent the country at the prestigious World Youth

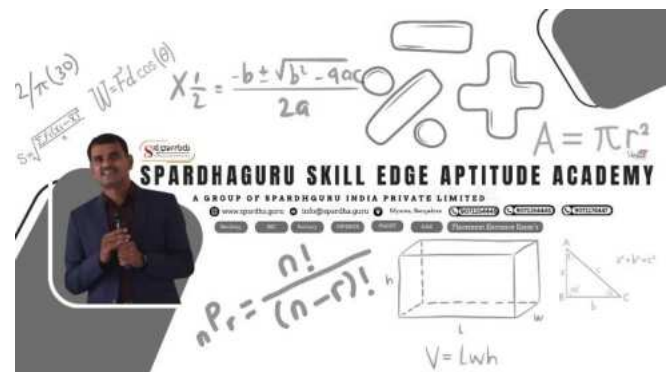

Philippines Declares Energy Emergency Amid Iran Conflict



As escalating tensions between the US - Israel - Iran conflict the Philippines has declared a national energy emergency.

Philippines President Ferdinand Marcos Jr.

announced the move citing an as an imminent danger to the country's energy supply. The crisis shows how the global conflicts are directly impacting fuel availability and prices especially those energy import dependent nations.

India Extends Inflation Targeting Framework Until March 2031



The Government of India has directed the Reserve Bank of India to continue pre decided retail inflation target at 4%

(+ or -) till March 2031 and reaffirming its commitment to price stability. With this it marks the second extension of India's inflation targeting framework since its introduction in 2016. The move looks like a continuity in monetary policy when the global uncertainty all around. As per this number of inflation currently at 3.21% (February 2026) and the framework aims to balance economic growth while keeping prices under control.

Historical and Technical Events of 28th march 2026

1798: Switzerland becomes a republic.



In 1798, following the French Revolution, French forces invaded Switzerland and established a

centralised state, the Helvetic Republic, which existed from 1798 to 1803. In 1798, French forces invaded Switzerland and abolished the original confederation of the Thirteen Cantons. In the Helvetic Republic, the cantons (previously independent states) were transformed into administrative units and redivided along the lines of French departments.

1901 - Federal elections held for the first time in Australia.



The 1901 Australian federal election was held in Australia on Saturday 29 March and Saturday 30

March 1901 for the first Parliament of Australia. These elections took place after federation and the establishment of the Commonwealth of Australia on 1 January 1901. All 75 seats in the Australian House of Representatives, six of which were uncontested, as well as all 36 seats in the Australian Senate were up for election.

1943 - Freedom fighter Laxman Nayak was hanged in Berhampur Jail.



Laxman Nayak was the undisputed tribal leader of undivided Koraput district who joined the Indian freedom movement on the call of Gandhiji.

He was born on 22 November 1899 and was hanged by the British government on 29 March 1943 at the young age of 43 in Berhampur Jail. He belonged to the Bhuiyan tribe of Odisha. He was born in Tentuliguma village of Koraput district and his father Padalam Nayak was a tribal chieftain and 'Mustadar' under 'Jaipur Samasthanam' in the then Madras Presidency.

1967 - France launches its first nuclear submarine.



In 1967, France launched its first nuclear submarine, "Le Redoutable", a ballistic missile submarine, marking an important

step in France's pursuit of an independent nuclear deterrent. The launch marked an important step in France's development of an independent nuclear deterrent, with the aim of joining the ranks of nuclear powers. The submarine has been preserved as a museum ship at the Cité de la Mer Naval Museum in Cherbourg-Octeville, France since 2002.

1954 - Indian Institute of Public Administration inaugurated.



In 1954, on March, Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, the first Prime Minister of India, as the first President of the Society, formally inaugurated the

Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA) in New Delhi. The Institute was established to equip public servants with the knowledge, skills and practical competencies required to manage the work of governance. The Indian Institute of Public Administration was established under the Societies Act of 1860.
