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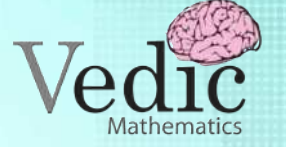

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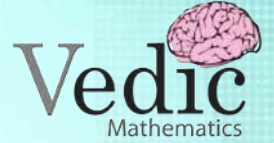

### Japan to Restart World's Largest Nuclear Plant After Fukushima Shutdown



In a significant shift for global energy policy, Japan is poised to restart the **Kashiwazaki-Kariwa Nuclear Power Plant**, the world's largest nuclear facility, nearly 15 years after the 2011 Fukushima disaster.

Following a pivotal vote of confidence on **December 22, 2025**, the Niigata Prefectural Assembly cleared the final local hurdle for the facility to resume operations. This move is a cornerstone of Japan's updated energy strategy, which aims for nuclear





power to provide 20% of the nation's electricity by 2040.
