India's aviation sector is set to get a major boost as Honorable Prime Minister Narendra Modi will inaugurate the Noida International

Airport on March, 2026, in Jewar, Uttar Pradesh. With this launch it marks the Phase I of one of India's largest greenfield airport projects and it is designed to enhance connectivity and ease congestion in the Delhi-NCR region. The new airport will function alongside the Indira Gandhi International Airport and will be creating a dual-airport system and will strengthen India's aviation hub.

Historical and Technical Events of 30th march 2026

1959- Buddhist spiritual leader Dalai Lama was given refuge in India after his exile from Tibet.



After the uprising against Chinese rule in Tibet in 1959, the Dalai Lama was given refuge in India, where he established the Tibetan government in exile and has been living there since then. India gave refuge to the Dalai Lama, and he established the Tibetan government in exile in Dharamsala, Himachal Pradesh. The Dalai Lama entered the Indian border by crossing the inaccessible hills and valleys of the Himalayas on foot.

1964- Electric trams run for the last time in Bombay.



On March, 1964, the last electric tram in Mumbai made its last journey between Bori Bunder (now Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus) and Dadar Tram Terminus (now Dadar T.T.). The tram system was discontinued due to low ridership, operating losses and the rise of bus services, which were considered more efficient and convenient.

1865: Anandibai Joshi, the country's first female doctor, was born.



Anandi Gopal Joshi, who hailed from the Bombay Presidency, was one of the first Indian-origin female doctors to study and graduate with a two-year degree in Western medicine from the United States. Interestingly, she is considered to be one of the first Indian women to become a doctor. Born on March, 1865 in Kalyan, Bombay Presidency, Anandi was originally named Yamuna by her father. She was raised in a Maharashtrian family who used to be landowners before bad times.

1774: Bengal Governor Warren Hastings established the country's first head post office in Kolkata.



In 1774, Bengal Governor Warren Hastings established India's first head post office in Kolkata, marking a significant step towards the beginning of the postal system in India. In its 250-year history, it has served as a testament to the evolution of postal services in the country. The Kolkata GPO's pivotal role in shaping India's postal landscape is being celebrated this month.

1889: Paris's famous Eiffel Tower officially opens.



The Eiffel Tower was inaugurated on March 1889 after two years and two months of construction. The world's tallest building was the main monument of the 1889 Paris World's Fair, the theme of which was the French Revolution. It is coated with rust-proof material every seven years, after which it is given a coat of paint. Its painting is still done manually, a traditional method and was mentioned by the great Ghetto Eiffel.
