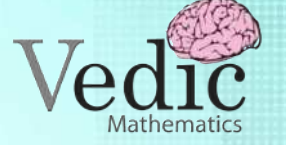

Sand Artist Sudarsan Pattnaik Sets World Record With Giant Santa Claus



That is an incredible feat of artistic engineering! Sudarsan Pattnaik continues to push the boundaries of sand art by integrating perishable elements like fruit to create massive, record-breaking installations.

To give you a better sense of the scale and context of this achievement, here is a breakdown of what makes this installation so unique:

The Scale of the "Apple Santa"

The sheer dimensions of this sculpture are difficult to visualize without comparing them to everyday objects. At **60 feet long** and **22 feet high**, the Santa Claus was roughly the height of a two-story building and the length of three large SUVs parked end-to-end.

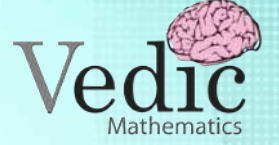

Why This Record Matters

Sudarsan Pattnaik's work is rarely just about the visual spectacle; it almost always carries a **social or environmental message**. By using apples—a symbol often associated with health and sharing—he transformed the beach into a space for reflection on global peace.

- **Sustainability:** After such records are set, Pattnaik often ensures the fruit used is distributed or composted, though the specific distribution for the 2025 installation usually follows a tradition of sharing with local communities.
- **Tourism Impact:** Puri is already a major spiritual hub, but these world-record attempts have turned Niladri Beach into a global landmark for "Sand Art Tourism."

About the Artist

Sudarsan Pattnaik is a world-renowned sand artist from Odisha. He was awarded the **Padma**

Shri (India's fourth-highest civilian award) in 2014. He has represented India in over 60 international sand art championships, winning numerous awards for his intricate designs and "Art for Cause" philosophy.

First Indian Standard for Agarbattis Unveiled By BIS



This is a landmark move for a product found in nearly every Indian household. By introducing **IS 19412:2025**, the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) is addressing a long-standing "silent" health issue: the inhalation of toxic fumes from unregulated incense sticks.

The timing of this announcement on **National Consumer Day 2025** underscores the government's focus on consumer rights and health. Here is a more detailed look at the impact and specifics of this new standard:

The "Banned List": Why It Matters

The standard explicitly prohibits substances that were often used to make agarbattis double as mosquito repellents or to artificially boost scent at a low cost.



Category	Banned Substances	Primary Health/Env. Concern
Insecticides	Alethrin, Permethrin, Cypermethrin, Deltamethrin, Fipronil	Neurotoxicity, respiratory distress, and harm to aquatic life.
Synthetic Chemicals	Benzyl cyanide, Ethyl acrylate, Diphenylamine	Skin/eye irritation, potential carcinogenicity, and poor indoor air quality.

Three-Tier Classification

To respect traditional craftsmanship while ensuring safety, the BIS has categorized agarbattis into three types:

- Machine-made:** Produced in large volumes with automated rolling.
- Hand-made:** Traditionally rolled, often in cottage industries.
- Masala Agarbattis:** Traditional sticks made using natural pastes, herbs, and resins rather than charcoal and oils.

Note: Products that meet these new norms will be eligible to carry the **BIS Standard Mark** (ISI mark), allowing you to identify safer options on the shelf.

Industry & Economic Significance

India dominates the global incense market, and this standard acts as a "quality passport" for international trade.

- Market Size:** The Indian agarbatti industry is valued at approximately ₹8,000 crore annually.
- Exports:** India exports roughly ₹1,200 crore worth of incense to over 150 countries (major markets include the US, UK, and Nigeria).
- Global Compliance:** Many of the newly banned chemicals are already restricted in Europe and North America. This standard helps Indian exporters meet global norms more easily.
- Social Impact:** The sector provides massive employment, particularly for **women in rural areas**, and this move encourages

China Opens World's Longest Expressway Tunnel in Xinjiang



The opening of the **Tianshan Shengli Tunnel** marks a historic moment in civil engineering, effectively "erasing" a natural barrier that has

separated northern and southern Xinjiang for centuries.

Officially opened to traffic on **December 26, 2025**, this 22.13 km marvel is now the crown jewel of the **G0711 Urumqi-Yuli Expressway**. It has turned a once-treacherous seven-hour journey across the "Celestial Mountains" into a swift trip of just over three hours.

Engineering & Record-Breaking Feats

The tunnel is not just long; it is deep and technically complex, setting two significant world records:

- **World's Longest Expressway Tunnel:** At **22.13 km**, it surpasses previous expressway records, specifically designed to handle high-speed traffic flows.
- **Deepest Vertical Shaft:** To ensure air circulation and safety in such a long stretch, engineers built a vertical ventilation shaft reaching a depth of **1,112 meters** (about 3,648 feet)—the deepest of its kind for a highway tunnel globally.

Impact on the Region

The Tianshan Mountains traditionally divided the regional capital, **Urumqi**, from southern hubs like **Korla**. The tunnel changes the logistics landscape of the Silk Road Economic Belt:

1. **Safety & Reliability:** Previously, the mountain passes were often closed due to heavy snow and ice. The tunnel provides an all-weather, year-round passage.
2. **Economic Integration:** Logistics companies expect freight delivery times between northern and southern Xinjiang to be cut by nearly half, significantly reducing costs for fresh produce and industrial goods.
3. **Tourism & Environment:** The expressway includes 17 tunnels and 36 bridges designed specifically to allow for **wildlife passages**, ensuring that the migration of local species is not disrupted by the new high-speed link.

Driver Experience

To combat the monotony and "tunnel hypnosis" often felt in ultra-long tunnels, engineers installed **three scenic zones** featuring murals and special lighting to keep drivers alert and engaged during the roughly 20-minute transit through the mountain.

PV Sindhu Elected Chair of BWF Athletes Commission



This is a defining moment for **PV Sindhu** as she transitions from being a champion on the court to a powerful voice in the boardroom.

On **December 24, 2025**, the Badminton World Federation (BWF) officially announced that Sindhu has been elected **Chair of the BWF Athletes' Commission** for the 2026–2029 term. This elevation is especially significant because it grants her a full voting seat on the **BWF Council**, allowing her to directly influence the global governance of the sport.

Key Highlights of the Appointment

- Leadership Role:** Sindhu will lead a five-member commission as Chair, succeeding Indonesian legend **Greysia Polli**.
- Direct Governance:** As Chair, she becomes a member of the BWF Council, the highest decision-making body in world badminton.
- Experience:** This is Sindhu's third consecutive term on the Commission (having served since 2017).⁵ She has also been a BWF Integrity Ambassador since 2020.
- Mandate:** Her focus will be on athlete welfare, mental health, injury prevention, and acting as a bridge between the players and the administration.

Vaibhav Suryavanshi Receives PM Rashtriya Bal Puraskar from President of India



Vaibhav Suryavanshi's recognition with the **Pradhan Mantri Rashtriya Bal Puraskar** on **December 26, 2025,** is the crowning achievement of what has been a truly historic year for the young cricketer.

At just 14 years old, the Bihar-born prodigy received the honor from President Droupadi Murmu at Rashtrapati Bhavan. The award recognizes him as a "once-in-a-generation" talent who has systematically dismantled long-standing records in world cricket.

A Season of World Records

Suryavanshi's 2025 season has been nothing short of extraordinary, featuring milestones that have made him a global sensation:

- **Youngest List A Centurion:** On December 24, 2024, he smashed **190 off 84 balls** for Bihar against Arunachal Pradesh in the Vijay Hazare Trophy. At 14 years and 272 days, he became the youngest player in history to score a List A century, breaking a 39-year-old record held by Pakistan's Zahoor Elahi.
- **Fastest 150 in History:** During that same 190-run knock, he reached 150 in just **59 balls**, eclipsing the world record previously held by AB de Villiers (64 balls).
- **IPL History Maker:** Playing for **Rajasthan Royals**, he became the youngest player to debut in the IPL (14 years and 23 days) and the youngest to score an IPL century (101 off 38 balls against Gujarat Titans).
- **Digital Phenom:** Reflecting his massive impact, he was the **most-searched Indian on Google in 2024** and only the second Indian cricketer (after Virat Kohli) to be personally spotlighted by Instagram's official global page.

Despite his record-breaking form, Suryavanshi faces a unique hurdle for the senior national team. Under **ICC regulations**, a player must be at least **15 years old** to debut in international cricket. Having been born on March 27, 2011, he will become eligible for a potential Team India call-up starting **March 27, 2026**.

Until then, he remains a vital part of the India Under-19 squad and will be traveling to Zimbabwe shortly to prepare for the 2026 U-19 World Cup.

Udhayanidhi Stalin lays foundation for Mudhalvar Padaippagam at Harbour constituency

- **Purpose:** To provide a professional environment for freelancers, startups, and students at highly subsidized rates, ensuring that residents of North Chennai have access to the same resources as those in the city's southern hubs.

2. Broadway Power Substation

To address long-standing electricity issues in the dense commercial hub of Broadway, a new **33/11 kV substation** was inaugurated.

- **Location:** Davidson Road, Broadway.
- **Cost:** ₹18.24 crore.
