I. Major International Events & Indian Participation:

Wimbledon 2025: The Men's Singles title at Wimbledon 2025 was won by Jannik Sinner, who defeated Carlos Alcaraz in the final on Sunday, July 13, 2025.

FIDE Women's World Cup Final: Indian chess enthusiasts are keenly following the FIDE Women's World Cup in Batumi, Georgia, which is currently seeing an all-Indian final. Koneru Humpy (38) is battling against the younger Divya Deshmukh (19) in a two-game final that started today, July 26, 2025. This is being described as a "battle of contrasting styles," with Humpy known for her solid approach and Deshmukh for her aggressive play.

World Athletics Championships 2025 (Tokyo, September 2025): Sparanaguru

Indian Relay Teams Miss Direct Qualification: India's men's and mixed 4x400m relay teams failed to secure direct qualification for the World Athletics Championships from the World Athletics Relays 2025 in Guangzhou in May. They will now rely on top performance lists during the qualification window which closes on August 24, 2025.

Continental Tour Bronze Event: The Athletics Federation of India (AFI) has released a list of eligible Indian athletes for the World Athletics Continental Tour Bronze event in Bhubaneswar, which serves as a qualification pathway. Top Indian athletes, though not Neeraj Chopra, are expected to participate.

Asian Athletics Championships 2025 (Gumi, South Korea - May 2025): India finished second in the medal tally with 24 medals (8 gold, 10 silver, 6 bronze). Animesh Kujur and Parul Chaudhary set new National Records.

FIH Hockey World Cup 2026: Both the Men's and Women's FIH Hockey World Cups in 2026 will be jointly hosted by Belgium (Wavre) and Netherlands (Amstelveen) from August 14 to 30, 2026. India is expected to compete, with the Men's Asia Cup 2025 (a qualifier for the World Cup) scheduled to be hosted in Raigir, India, from August 29 to September 7, 2025.


World Championship of Legends 2025: A match between India Champions and Australia Champions is scheduled for July 26, 2025.

It supersedes the 2001 policy and is anchored on five key pillars: Excellence on the Global Stage, Sports for Economic Development, Sports for Social Development, Sports as a People's Movement, and Integration with Education (NEP 2020).

strengthening grassroots emphasizes programs, developing sports infrastructure (both rural and urban), building world-class training systems, encouraging private sector participation (PPP, CSR), promoting sports tourism, and leveraging technology like AI for performance tracking.

The policy also reconsiders the ban on Persons of Indian Origin (PIOs) and Overseas Citizens of India (OCIs) representing India.

Revolutionizing Indian **Sports** Infrastructure (2025 Trends):

Sustainability: Increased demand for ecofriendly facilities using green building materials, solar power, and rainwater harvesting (e.g., National Games Village in Gujarat).

Multi-Purpose & Modular Stadiums: Trend towards flexible venues, especially in Tier 2 and Tier 3 cities, for greater resource utilization.

Synthetic & Hybrid Turfs: Shift from traditional grass fields to synthetic and hybrid turfs for durability, performance, consistent and minimal (FIFA FIHmaintenance and approved).

Smart Technologies: Integration of AI and data analytics for performance tracking, stadium management, and automated ticketing.

Private Sector & Government Collaborations: Public-private partnerships (PPPs) are leading infrastructure development, with government funding from schemes like Khelo India and Fit India Movement.

Grassroots Focus: Emphasis on establishing small local sports complexes and training academies in smaller towns and rural areas, evidenced by the launch of mini-stadiums.

High-Performance Training Centers (HPCs): Establishment of advanced HPCs with fitness labs and sports science units to equip athletes for top-level competition.


IV. Other Notable Sports News:


