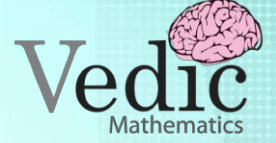

1. India's Bid to Host Commonwealth Games:

The Indian Olympic Association (IOA) has officially approved India's bid to host the 2030 Commonwealth Games. Ahmedabad has been put forward as the proposed host city. India previously hosted the event in Delhi in 2010.

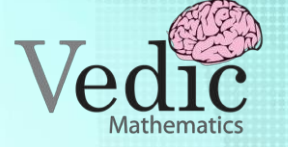
