Indian Sports Highlights:

Squash: Teen sensation Anahat Singh is leading a 12-member Indian contingent at the World Junior Squash Championships in Cairo, starting today. She is seeded second in the women's draw and is in rich form, having recently clinched the U19 Asian girls' title and Asian senior doubles gold.

Chess:

Koneru Humpy has made history by becoming the first Indian woman to reach the semifinals of the FIDE Women's World Cup in Batumi, Georgia. This also assures India of at least one spot in the 2026 Candidates tournament.

India has had a strong showing in the FIDE Women's Chess World Cup 2025, becoming the first nation with four quarterfinalists.

India is set to host the 2025 FIDE World Cup from October 30 to November 2. The top three finishers will qualify for the 2026 Candidates Tournament.

Wrestling: Indian Greco-Roman wrestlers had a strong outing at the Polyak Imre & Varga Janos Memorial 2025 wrestling tournament in Budapest, Hungary. Under-23 Asian champion Sumit won a silver medal in the 60kg category, and Anil Mor secured a bronze. In other news, Antim Panghal, Sujeet Kalkal, and Harshita won gold medals at the same event, contributing to Indian women wrestlers winning the team title.

Badminton: India has scripted history by clinching its first-ever medal in badminton at the FISU World University Games in Berlin, Germany (a bronze).

Athletics: Murali Sreeshankar clinched the Long Jump title at the Portugal Sports Meet with a leap of 7.75 meters. Srihari Nataraj bettered his 'Best Indian Performance' in 100m freestyle swimming at the World University Games.

Cricket (India vs England Test Series):

India's preparation for the 4th Test against England in Manchester has been hampered by injuries. All-rounder Nitish Kumar Reddy has been ruled out of the remaining two Tests due to a left knee injury.

Left-arm seamer Arshdeep Singh is also sidelined for the 4th Test due to a thumb injury sustained in the nets. Anshul Kamboj has been added to the Indian squad as cover.

Concerns remain over the fitness of Rishabh Pant (index finger injury).

Cricket (World Championship of Legends 2025): The highly anticipated India vs Pakistan match in the World Championship of Legends (WCL) 2025 was officially cancelled. Several former Indian players, including Shikhar Dhawan, Irfan Pathan, Yusuf Pathan, and Harbhajan Singh, withdrew from the fixture, citing the Pahalgam terror attack in April and the geopolitical situation. This decision has sparked controversy and criticism from former Pakistan captain Shahid Afridi.

Football: The third edition of the Oriental Cup, a youth football tournament, is set to kick off a Dr. Ambedkar Stadium in Delhi with 36 teams competing.



Government Initiatives: The Union government is set to introduce a sports governance Bill in the Parliament session, aiming to strengthen India's bid for the 2036 Olympic Games. The bill proposes setting up a National Sports Board (NSB) and a National Sports Tribunal for dispute resolution.


