Cricket: Asia Cup and BCCI Updates

Asia Cup 2025: The Asia Cup is in full swing. India, fresh off a dominant nine-wicket victory over the UAE, is preparing for a highly anticipated clash against Pakistan on Sunday, September 14. Pakistan also started their campaign with a decisive win against Oman.

Tennis: In the Davis Cup, India's team, led by Sumit Nagal, is facing Switzerland in a World Group I tie. India is currently leading 2-0 after victories by Nagal and Dhakshineswar Suresh.


