Paris – Nearly two years have passed since France's then-foreign minister, Laurent Fabius, struck his gavel and declared: "The Paris agreement for the climate is ___(1)___accepted." Next week, President Emmanuel Macron and the French government will host world leaders and non-state actors for the One Planet Summit. The major central banks' ____ (1) ____ negligent pursuit of positive but low inflation has become a dangerous ____ (2) ____ delusion. In the 1970s, when inflation in the advanced economies rose sharply, central banks rightly ____ (3) ____ adhere it. The lesson central bankers took from that battle was that low inflation is a necessary condition for sustained growth. But, subtly and over time, this lesson has ____ (4) ____ morphed into a belief that low inflation is also a sufficient condition for sustained growth. For central bankers, it was comforting to believe that they had reduced inflation by controlling demand, and that their policies had many beneficial side effects for the economy. From the late 1980s onward, low inflation was largely due to positive supply-side shocks – such as the Baby Boomer-fueled expansion of the labor force and the ____ (7) ____ hostility of many emerging countries into the global trading system. These forces boosted growth while lowering inflation. And monetary policy, far from restricting demand, was generally focused on preventing below-target inflation. As we now know, that led to a period of easy monetary conditions,

which, together with financial deregulation and technological developments, ____ (8) ____ sowed the seeds of the 2007 financial crisis and the ensuing recession. The fundamental analytical error then – as it still is today – was a failure to ____ (9) ____ degrade between alternative sources of disinflation. The end of the Great ____ (10) ____ indulgence should have disabused policymakers of their belief that low inflation guarantees future economic stability. If anything, the opposite has been true. Having doubled down on their inflation targets, central banks have had to rely on an unprecedented array of untested policy instruments to achieve their goals.
